· A Yogi can become a Baktha easily. But a Baktha can't become a yogi easily.

 Yogi and Baktha will meet only at the point of GOD-REALISATION. • For me, 'YOGIC BAKTHI' is the Real Expressway to realize God easily.

To be a YOGI, you have to do all the Hard Work. But for a BAKTHA, God will do all the work.

There can be thousands of Bakthas, but none can match the quality of MEERA, ANDAL, MALLAMMA, AKKAMMA, SAHAJO BAI and DAYA MATHA.  Torturing the Body in the name of bakthi is not BAKTHI at all. A visit to PANDARPUR is a must for all of us to taste the real flavour of bakthi. The vibrations of the great BAKTHAS still lingers very much in that air.

 Colourful and Enchanting.  In the path of Bakthi, the Baktha gets totally dissolved in GOD. • Baktha always lives in the Company of GOD.
